5. Transform Leatherhead

For this item we welcomed Cllr Howard Jones (Executive member for Town Centres) who outlined some of the proposals under consideration. Details are still available from http://www.molevalley.gov.uk/transformleatherhead (see Downloads section) although the Stage 2 consultation period has now ended. A Masterplan will now be developed from the Stage 2 draft by March, with a final consultation on this completing by the end of June. An important message seems to be that walking and cycling are now being taken into account at the outset, rather than as an afterthought. Money for any such infrastructure would come from LEP subsidiary funds for Sustainable Development. There was a brief discussion on whether the NCN should come through the Leatherhead area. **BB** to follow this up.

6. Surrey Cycling Strategy – Mole Valley Local Cycling Plan

The progress update on the Mole Valley Cycling Strategy (<u>http://www.molevalley.gov.uk/media/pdf/c/3/item_08(i)</u> - <u>Local_Cycling_Plan_- Progress_Update.pdf</u>) was approved at the last Local Committee meeting where a map of potential new cycling routes was circulated. There is still no news of any consultation in the south of Mole Valley. RS has since followed this up with Lucy O'Connell, RT is following it up with Becky Willson.

7. Route Development Updates

Nothing to report unless mentioned below.

NB. MVDC's Infrastructure Needs Assessment – see <u>http://www.molevalley.gov.uk/ina</u> is a good opportunity to lobby for cycle infrastructure improvements in Mole Valley. Closing date for the responses is 29th Feb.

Leatherhead-Area

<u>Leatherhead-Ashtead Cycle Path:</u> This is slowly getting more popular. It was agreed to remove this from the agenda. <u>Randalls Road:</u> This now features on the Local Committee list although we don't know if there are any plans yet. <u>Safe Routes to Schools (Therfield):</u> Nothing likely to happen whilst Transform Leatherhead is under way.

Bookham/Effingham area

Safe Routes to Schools (Howard of Effingham): The decision on the planning application to rebuild the school has been put back.

Dorking area

Dorking Southbound: RT to check progress with Paul Manwaring.

Dorking Centre – Brockham link: RT had raised this via the INA.

<u>Dorking Centre – Meadowbank links:</u> As reported in the local press, the football ground redevelopment has been delayed.

8. Other Updates

Nothing to report unless mentioned below.

Dorking Transport Package (Deepdene Station): RS noted that there had been a meeting today

<u>Dorking Hub</u>: RB reported that they are now in a position to consult on the design, they are waiting on elevation drawings before submitting a planning application. If all the approvals go through without a delay they are looking to complete by early April 2016. The facility will be a secure hub with a key card access for 220 spaces with a further 20 spaces external to the hub. *RB* to set up an onsite meeting. It was queried whether the money saved on the Dorking plans (original ~500 spaces) could be used to improve the facilities at Leatherhead.

9. AOB

JD asked for Polesden Lacey routes to be added back into the agenda. Action RT.

JD also mentioned the Celebrate Cycling event on Bookham Common planned for Sun 26th June.

JC raised a number of issues he saw with the signing and surfaces on R22. *JC to follow up offline with BB and RT.* BB reported that he had raised a number of issues with R22 between Dorking and Westcott at the last Local

Committee meeting and is waiting on a site meeting with Highways Officers.

RT mentioned that he had raised the issue of the failure to refresh off-highway cycle markings at the Local Committee. Surrey Highways accept there is a problem and are looking into it.
